



Celtic Weave Cowl



Notes

Celtic weave bordered by a waffle stitch.

Pattern has 2 weaves allowing for a wider look or folded in half, becoming thicker, narrower, and double-sided.

4mm hook and 8 ply yarn results in a blocked work around 90 cm long and 36 cm wide

Glossary

ch = Chain

bpdc = Back-Post Double Crochet

dcdec = Double Crochet Decrease

dc = Double Crochet

fpdc = Front-Post Double Crochet

sc = Single Crochet

st(s). = Stitch(es)

Pattern

1. ch 79, turn. (79)
2. dc 77 (start second st. from hook), ch 1, turn. (77)
3. dc (same st.), (fpdc 1, dc 2) x 25, fpdc 1, dc 1, ch 1, turn. (77)
4. dc (same st.), (dc 1, fpdc 2) x 25, dc 2, ch 1, turn. (77)
5. Repeat row 3. (77)
6. Repeat row 4. (77)
7. Repeat row 3. (77)
8. dc (same st.), dc, (fpdc 2, dc) x 3, fpdc 2, (sk 2, tc 2, tc 2 (in skipped st.s)) x 4, (fpdc 2, dc) x 6, fpdc 2, (sk 2, tc 2, tc 2 (in skipped st.s)) x 4, fpdc 2, dc, (fpdc 2, dc) x 3, dc, ch 1, turn. (77) [tc need to follow the same pattern of being tc and fptc as the waffle stitch as determined by the pattern in the previous row] [Inside twist]
9. dc (same st.), fpdc, (dc 2, fpdc) x 3, (sk 2, fptc 2, fptc (in skipped st.s)) x 4, fpdc 2, (fpdc 2, dc) x 6, fpdc 2, (sk 2, fptc 2, fptc (in skipped st.s)) x 4, fpdc, (dc 2, fpdc) x 3, dc, ch 1, turn. (77) [Outside twist]
10. dc (same st.), dc, (fpdc 2, dc) x 3, bpdc 2, (sk 2, bptc 2, bptc 2 (in skipped st.s)) x 4, (fpdc 2, dc) x 6, fpdc 2, (sk 2, bptc 2, bptc 2 (in skipped st.s)) x 4, bpdc 2, dc, (fpdc 2, dc) x 3, dc, ch 1, turn. (77) [Inside twist] [bptc in the skipped stitches should be from the front side of the piece]
- 11 - 96. repeat rows 9 and 10, alternating
97. Repeat row 3. (77)
98. Repeat row 4. (77)
99. Repeat row 3. (77)
100. Repeat row 4. (77)
101. Repeat row 3. (77)
102. Repeat row 4. (77)
103. dc (same st.), dc 76 (77)

Tie off, wave in ends, block, use cufflinks as fasteners.
